INSTRUCTION: CLASS RANK Board Policy 2422

The board acknowledges the usefulness of a system of computing grade point averages and class ranking for secondary school graduates to inform students, parents and others of their relative academic placement among their peers.

The board authorizes a system of class ranking, by grade point average, for students in grades 9-12.

A student's grade point average shall be reported on his/her term grade report.

As directed by the Superintendent, the building Principal shall develop a building procedure for determining class rank, establishing Valedictorian and Salutatorian awards, and for recognizing individual students for their achievement.
